

## CMH RESTRICTED VISITATION POLICY – effective October 24, 2020

<b>EMERGENCY ROOM PATIENTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Pediatric patients or patients with special needs</b> - may have one (1) support person</li> <li>• Visitors and others will be discouraged from sitting in waiting room.</li> </ul>	Hours – 24/7
<b>BEDDED PATIENTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Pediatric patients or patients with special needs</b> - may have one (1) support person</li> <li>• Must have visitor pass</li> </ul>	Hours – 24/7
<b>OUTPATIENT SERVICES</b> (includes Cancer Center)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Pediatric patients or patients with special needs</b> - may have one (1) support person</li> </ul>	Hours – 24/7
<b>OUTPATIENT SURGERY PATIENTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>BLUE</b> armband will be provided to one (1) outpatient surgery support person</li> </ul>	Hours – 24/7
<b>MBCU DELIVERY PATIENTS &amp; INFANT BEDDED PATIENTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>GREEN</b> armband will be provided to the patients' one (1) support person by the MBCU staff</li> </ul>	The support person will be permitted to come and go 24/7 while wearing armband
<b>END OF LIFE/CRITICAL PATIENT</b> (if patient suspected or confirmed COVID-19, no visitors will be allowed)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May have one (1) visitor at a time</li> <li>• Must have a visitor's room number pass</li> <li>• In the event of an end of life/critical situation, the nursing supervisor will notify the CMH Operator or screening stations that additional family members may be expected to visit the patient</li> </ul>	Hours 24/7
<b>WOUND CARE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>If indicated on Wound Care's daily schedule</b>, may have one (1) support person accompany to appointment</li> </ul>	
<b>MEDICAL RECORDS REQUESTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Customer will wait at Atrium screening station for Medical Records staff to deliver records requested</li> </ul>	
<b>POB LOBBY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May have one (1) support person</li> <li>• Offices may enforce stricter visitor procedure</li> </ul>	

### Visitors must:

- Be older than 15 years of age
- Be screened for symptoms of exposure history – *visitor will be asked to leave if they have had symptoms in the past 24 hours or exposure in the last 14 days*
- Wear a mask covering the nose and mouth at all times – *if visitor refuses, may be asked to leave the facility unless unable to wear a mask due to health or disability issues*
- Wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before entering and after leaving rooms and hospital buildings
