OUTPATIENT SURGERY PATIENTS	BLUE armband will be provided to one (1) outpatient surgery support person	Hours – 24/7
MBCU DELIVERY PATIENTS & INFANT BEDDED PATIENTS	GREEN armband will be provided to the patients' one (1) support person by the MBCU staff	The support person will be permitted to come and go 24/7 while wearing armband
END OF LIFE/CRITICAL PATIENT (if patient suspected or confirmed COVID-19, no visitors will be allowed)	<ul> <li>May have one (1) visitor at a time</li> <li>Must have a visitor's room number pass</li> <li>In the event of an end of life/critical situation, the nursing supervisor will notify the CMH Operator or screening stations that additional family members may be expected to visit the patient</li> </ul>	Hours 24/7
WOUND CARE	If indicated on Wound Care's daily schedule, may have one (1) support person accompany to appointment	
MEDICAL RECORDS REQUESTS	Customer will wait at Atrium screening station for Medical Records staff to deliver records requested	
POB LOBBY	<ul><li>May have one (1) support person</li><li>Offices may enforce stricter visitor procedure</li></ul>	

## **Visitors must:**

- Be older than 15 years of age
- Be screened for symptoms of exposure history visitor will be asked to leave if they have had symptoms in the past 24 hours or exposure in the last 14 days
- Wear a mask covering the nose and mouth at all times if visitor refuses, may be asked to leave the facility unless unable to wear a mask due to health or disability issues
- Wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before entering and after leaving rooms and hospital buildings
